### Configure Outlook Express 5+

Outlook Express is an E-Mail application included with Internet Explorer. When you install Internet Explorer; it may have taken your current e-mail settings to be used for Outlook Express. Therefore, Outlook Express may already be configured with your ISP e-mail configuration. If it isn't, or if you would like to add an e-mail address to Outlook Express, follow procedure below. You can configure Outlook Express to chaek as many e-mail address as you like.

#### To add an e-mail account to Outlook Express:

- Start Outlook Express.
- Choose Accounts from the Tools menu. The Internet Accounts window will open.
